Not A Pretender

Awhile back, I found myself in conversation with a lady who said she did not believe in God. Mostly I just listened while she aired frustrations about Christians (some were valid BTW). After a few minutes, she stopped and asked what I did for a living. I responded that I was a preacher, at which point, she apologized sheepishly for how she must have sounded. I told her not to worry, that I was not offended and that it was not the first time something like this had happened. This led to a good conversation about faith during which she asked an odd question that has stuck with me, "Isn't preaching kind of like acting?" I asked her what she meant, and she said, "Well, don't you have to pretend that everything is going well and pretend that what you are saying is the most important message?"

It was a unique question for sure and I have used it in my life to just how important it is that I, as a follower of God, let Christ live in me. For sure, I have days just like everyone else when I'm not exactly feeling like doing what I'm doing at the moment. But in those moments, I'm still going to do the best I can. I also know that not every sermon is the best nor most important, but as long as it is a message of truth, it is beneficial for someone at that time.

As followers of God, Christ lives in us, let that show. It does not mean that we are perfect, it doesn't mean that every day will be a good day, but even those times that don't go so well, we can still let Christ show in our lives. People are watching you and I...and I hope that when people see me, they see Christ, not a pretender.
