Mark 4:30-34 Understanding the Kingdom

I believe it is very important for disciples of Jesus to understand what the Kingdom of Heaven is all about. As we have seen in the topics we have addressed this year, Jesus spent time teaching his disciples about it. We are heirs of the kingdom and we live in it every day. Our basic task should be focused on **understanding the kingdom** so we can help others understand it as well.
