# **Paradoxes of Following God**

I have been thinking recently about some of the big paradoxes of following God. This might make a good series someday, but for now I will share them here briefly. I'm not going to spend much time here expanding on these paradoxes. They might be good to dwell on during some individual devotional time.

The first, is that eternal life is free, but it costs everything. Consider a couple verses, "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life," from Romans 6:23, and "whoever loses his life for my sake will save it," from Luke 9:24.

Second, following God is incredibly easy, but at the same time the most difficult thing a person will every try to do. Talking about the ease is Matthew 11:28-30, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for you souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light." On the opposite side is Matthew 10:22, "Everyone will hate you because of me," and John 16:33, "In this world you will have trouble."

Finally, following God is for imperfect people. Think about all the people Jesus went to and spent time with: Peter denied Jesus, the woman who had been married 5 times, Paul was a murderer. On the other hand, perfection is required: Matthew 5:48, "Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly father is perfect." I end with this one because not to say, "HEY BE PERFECT!" but to remind us that our perfection is not our own doing. We are made perfect only in Jesus, "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfector of faith."
