# **Trusting God**

My mother and sister came to visit us this week and they brought my niece and nephew with them. It was a short, chaotic, and ultimately wonderful visit. The reason they came to town was to take my daughters back to Tennessee with them for a week filled with fun and family out in the woods. If I'm being completely honest, this is a very scary and nerve wrecking proposition for Jadey and I. Not because we don't trust my family or because we think something bad will happen to them, but because their absence makes a real impact in our daily lives. We miss them. I don't know what they will do while they are there. I don't know how things will go or if they will get hurt or if they will be sad because they miss us. And that is perfectly okay. I love and trust my family. I know that they only have good plans for my children and that they love them more deeply than they can express. I might not know how everything is going or what they are doing but I trust that they are happy, and things are going well.

As children of God who are also being taken on a journey and there are a lot of similar feeling. We don't always know where we are going in life or what we are doing. We often don't understand what God is doing or where he is leading us. There are moments in life that we all feel fear or anxiety. Moments when we have questions. Trust in God. Habakkuk 3:17-18 says "Even though the fig trees have no blossoms, and there are no grapes on the vines; even though the olive crop fails, and the fields lie empty and barren; even though the flocks die in the fields, and the cattle barns are empty, 18 yet I will rejoice in the Lord! I will be joyful in the God of my salvation! The Sovereign Lord is my strength!" Habakkuk didn't understand what God was doing, but he trusted in his plans. Habakkuk didn't see where he was going, but he was as surefooted as a deer. He didn't fear the journey ahead because he believed he could overcome anything in his path. When my daughters take my parents by the hand, they trust them with all their heart to lead them the way they should go. They don't have fear because they know they are loved and protected. They know things will be okay. Reach out and grab God's hand. I promise you that it is there.
