Locked Doors and Annoying Crows

Tap, tap, tap. "Someone must be at the door," I think to myself. Peck, peck, peck. Squawk, squawk, squawk. Nope, just a crow attacking its reflection in the door...and losing I might add. Three or four feathers were on the ground, and I could see an outline where it had smacked the glass door a few times. I chased it away, but the next day...the same thing happened all over again. The crow just wouldn't seem give it up. This went on for a month or so before the bird quit coming. Maybe it learned, maybe it found another refection or maybe it knocked itself loony. Who knows? All I care about is that the incessant noise it gone.

I can't help but think that we are just like that dumb bird when we try to control our own lives. It is easy when WE think WE know best, WE know the right way, or WE know the thing to do to find ourselves encountering closed doors. Revelation 3:7, talking about Jesus as being holy and true, says that, "What he opens, no one can close; and what he closes, no one can open." How many of us have spent days, months, years trying to pry open doors that may be closed to us.

Here is another thing, when we are so focused on trying to force open one door, there is a good chance we miss a nearby door that is open. All it is waiting for is for us to stop and consider what God might have in store. Generally, if we lay out our plans and desires before God, then spend time asking what God would want us to do, we will find an answer. And often times, his answer will be a whole lot less painful and aggravating than what we had in mind.

So, the next time you see a bird attacking its reflection looking all disheveled and annoyed, let it be a reminder to look for God's ways. Consider Psalm 27:14, "Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord."
