Sermon Scripture: Matthew 1:18-25

### Sermon Thought:

Matthew refers to Jesus in three ways: 1. He is the Messiah, meaning, "anointed one," 2. the angel said his name would be Jesus, meaning, "the Lord saves," and 3. Immanuel, meaning, "God with us." In our context we don't tend to think much about the meaning of names. However, each of the names above makes a bold claim about who Jesus is and what God does for us.

## He Will Save His People From Their Sins

How far back do you know your genealogy? For myself, most branches I can go back 4-5 generations, but the longest I know goes back 12 generations to around 1640. Each of the generations before me helped shape me in one way or another: personality, physical characteristics, name sakes or places I lived. Almost none of them, okay none of them would be considered "famous," but on some level they are part of my story.

In Matthew 1, we learn about Jesus' story. The names listed include all kinds of people. There are heroes of faith like Abraham, Boaz and King David, but some were evil like Manasseh and Abijah. There are foreigners listed like Ruth. Unknown people like Nashon, Jeconiah, and Azor. Some with shady backgrounds like Rahab are included.

Human failures, triumphs or sins do not limit or cause success for God's work in history. He works through both remarkable and ordinary people. Just as God chose all kinds of people to be part of the lineage of Jesus, he uses all kinds today to accomplish his will, in the present and for the future.

God sent his son as the savior of all people-Jews, Gentiles, men, women, you and I. No matter who people are or where they come from, God's plan of salvation is offered to all people. The angel said as much to Joseph in telling him about Mary and Jesus in Matthew 1:21, "She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins."
