# Why Did Jesus Come?

At Christmas, some will think of the birth of Jesus. Although we don't know the exact date of His birth, it's most important to understand WHY Jesus came from heaven and was born as a baby. If you want to know why Jesus came, search for His "I have come" statements in Scripture (see Luke 19:10; John 6:38; 9:39; 10:10; 12:46; 18:37).

Here are a few reasons that Jesus came:

To show us God. "The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us. We have seen His glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth... "No one has ever seen God. The only Son, who is the same as God and is at the Father's side, he has made him known." (John 1:14, 18). If you want to know what God is like, look at Jesus.

To demonstrate God's love. "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16). "This is how God showed His love among us: He sent His one and only Son into the world that we might live through Him" (1 John 4:9). In order that we might live, Christ had to die for our sins (Romans 5:8).

To provide God's greatest gifts. Jesus came to give us salvation (Matthew 1:21) and eternal life (John 3:16). "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:23).

At Christmas, some may acknowledge that Christ was born into the world. May the world know WHY He came: to show us God, to show us how much God loves us, and to show what God wants to give us.

I hope that all of us will remember Jesus and why he came to this earth throughout all times of the year and not just at Christmas time.
