## **Heroes of Faith**

### Noah

Memories abound of the flooding we had on the farm where I grew up. I was always interested to see the volume of water in our pasture after a violent thunderstorm. Then there was the time when the flooding was so severe that it washed out a huge portion of the highway. Just as quickly as the water came up, so did it recede and things were back to normal. One of the sad things about flooding that involves your possessions, is that you can still see them but they are destroyed.

When the flood of sin corrupted mankind, "And the Lord was sorry that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him to his heart" (Gen. 6:6). He was determined to blot man from the face of the earth, but "Noah found favor in the eyes of the Lord" (Gen. 6:8) and eight precious souls were saved to carry on the life of God's creation. As the Hebrew writer puts it, "By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen, took heed and constructed an ark for the saving of his household; by this he condemned the world and became an heir of the righteousness which comes by faith" (Heb. 11:7). Noah's faith is amazing as he built an ark as God commanded him. The magnitude of the ark at that time was incomprehensible. That took a lot of faith. Then God told him there would be a "flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh in which is the breath of life from under heaven; everything that is on earth shall die" (Gen. 6:17). Even though there had been no rain upon the earth at that time, Noah believed God by faith and carried out God's details for building the ark. Noah is definitely one of our **Heroes of Faith** by what he did, and we are here today because of his faith. I know it grieved God to see everything he created destroyed even though he could still see it. I pray we will find favor in the eyes of the Lord, just as Noah did. Gordon.
