Get Your Hearing Checked

Matthew 13:43- Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of Father. Whomever has ears, let them hear.

Ear, ears, ears. We use our ears for lots of things- hearing, listening, place for your glasses, earrings, etc. Every day, people come into my office and express their concerns with their hearing or balance. Family members reveal their loved ones can't hear or maybe joke they have 'selective hearing.' My patients report they hear just fine. They blame their family for mumbling or not talking loud enough. One of my jobs is to recommend better forms of communication with my patient and their loved ones. As Christians, we need to work daily on better communications such as reading the Word, sharing our Faith, being an example, talking face to face, listening to one another, and praying daily.

The first hearing test I perform on my patient is marked as their Baseline. Baseline is the starting point and so year after year, we can determine if my patient's hearing has maintained or shifted. No two person's hearing is the same and each person's hearing is unique to that individual.

Romans 10:17- Consequently, Faith comes by hearing the message and the message is heard through the word about Christ.


So the challenge for us as Christians is are you maintaining yearly, following the recommendations for your degree of hearing or is your hearing declining? We need to all get our hearing checked!
