### **Heroes of Faith**

### Joseph

The journey of faith can have some very interesting twists as we will see in our next hero of faith. Joseph was Jacob's first son from Rachel, the wife he loved. He also loved Joseph more than any of his other children (Gen. 37:3). Because he was favored by his father, Joseph's brothers were jealous and hated him when Joseph told them of his dreams that they would bow down to him (vs 5-11). This resulted in our **hero of faith** being sold into Egyptian slavery (vs 25-28). Not the path one would expect of a person with a noble beginning. But Joseph's faith was strong, and he continued to give his best. He then found favor with Pharoah's captain of the guard. "The Lord was with Joseph, and he became a successful man" (Gen. 39:2).

Joseph was put in charge of everything in Potiphar's house, but things went bad again when he was falsely accused of trying to lie with Potiphar's wife. He was cast into prison, "But the Lord was with Joseph and showed him steadfast love and gave him favor in the sight of the keeper of the prison" (vs. 19-23). Joseph was again elevated when the Lord made him able to interpret Pharaoh's dreams about seven good years and seven lean years. Pharaoh told Joseph, "Since God has shown you all this, there is none so discreet and wise as you are; you shall be over my house, and all my people shall order themselves as you command; only as regards to the throne will I be greater than you" (Gen. 41:39-40). Joseph was indeed a powerful hero of faith as he not only rescued Egypt from disaster, but he also saved his father's family. Joseph told his brothers, "And now do not be distressed, or angry with yourselves, because you sold me here; for God sent me before you to preserve life" (Gen. 45:5). The Lord will also be with us as we keep the faith just as Joseph did.
