Talk to God First

Wisdom begins with respect for the Lord. And understanding begins with knowing God. - Proverbs 9:10

When you're surrounded by troubles, it's tempting to try to fix them yourself, isn't it? Don't! Because only God knows everything about your troubles and the perfect way to fix them. A man named Gehazi learned that lesson long ago. Gehazi was a servant of the prophet Elisha. When the king of Aram sent his massive army to capture Elisha, Gehazi was terrified. He and his master Elisha were surrounded by soldiers, horses, and chariots. "Master, what can we do?" Gehazi asked. Elisha simply prayed, "Lord, open my servant's eyes." Suddenly Gehazi saw that the Lord's heavenly army was all around them, ready to fight for them. The battle was already won (2 Kings 6:8-19). When you're surrounded by troubles, don't count only on what you can see and figure out for yourself. Count on God.

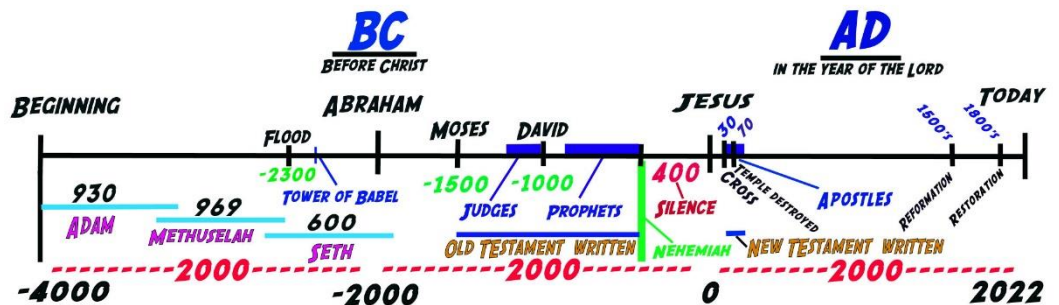
