Sermon Thought:

There are order forms on the welcome center for North Garland t-shirts. These t-shirts would be great to wear when participating in service projects or attending children's extra circular activities with a group from church.



Gospels: Reveal the Lord (John 14:8-10).


Acts (History): The implementation of the Church and the Great Commission from Matthew 28:18-20, "of all nations."
