Sermon Scripture: 1 Corinthians 12:12-31

Sermon Thought:

Last week we looked at the benefits of being a part of the church body. Today's sermon looked at the cost of being a part of the church body. When a person joins a group, in this case a group of believers, there should inherently be a surrendering of self at some level. When we choose to become followers of God, we submit to his ways. When we join a fitness club, school or church we agree to go along with whatever rules that group has put in place. This is called submission. Generally, people don't like to submit.

Sermon Questions:

1. Why is submission generally difficult to put in action?
2. Submission requires a certain amount of surrender or giving up one's own desires for the good of the whole. However, submission itself can have its own benefits, what are they?
3. How can we as individuals do a better job of being a part of the whole?
