Heroes of Faith

Hosea

Hosea is an incredible **hero of faith** by what God asked him to do and the prophetic message he proclaimed. His name means "salvation," and that is the outcome God desired for Israel because they were engaged in religious apostasy. To demonstrate what God saw from his heavenly perspective, he told Hosea to marry a harlot. "Go, take to yourself a wife of harlotry and have children of harlotry, for the land commits great harlotry by forsaking the Lord" (Hosea 1:2). Hosea did as the Lord asked and married Gomer who bore him three children.

We can't even begin to imagine the agony and personal grief our **hero of faith** felt as Gomer then gave herself to be a lover of other men. Her life of harlotry portrays the immoral state that Israel was in before God. While they kept the name of God, they gave themselves to the ritual and practices of Baal. What an amazing picture of God's love as Hosea even took care of Gomer's physical needs while she was committing immoral sexual acts. Then God told him to take her back and love her again as his wife. "Go again, love a woman who is beloved of a paramour and is an adulteress; even as the Lord loves the people of Israel, though they turn to other gods and love cakes and raisins" (vs. 2:1). Hosea was obedient to God in all he asked, and his experience gave him a powerful message to proclaim to Israel. Hosea's prophecy against Israel resulted in God taking them back just as he did Gomer. God tells Israel, "For I desire steadfast love and not sacrifice, the knowledge of God, rather than burnt offerings" (vs. 6:6). The life of our **hero of faith** stands as a testimony for our lives and the great nation of America to be mindful of our faithfulness and obedience to his commands. "...for the ways of the Lord are right, and the upright walk in them, but transgressors stumble in them" (vs.14:9).
