Sheep

Throughout scripture we see many references about sheep. Like "the Lord is my shepherd. . .," "You are my flock, the sheep of my pasture. . .," and many others! I was talking with my brother (who is working for a vet this summer) and one of his coworkers had an interesting quote:

"It is not always a blessing that we are called His flock, BUT it is a blessing that we are His flock."

If you have ever been around sheep, you understand what Amanda was getting at. But in case you haven't, let me fill you in. My family has raised sheep for over 50 years now and most days they aren't the most intelligent animals out there. They will dead sprint into fences, headbutt you at full speed when you aren't looking, and get stuck into things you don't think are possible to get stuck in (just go ask Baylor). When you go to free them from getting their head stuck in a fence, they will even fight you to keep their head stuck!

When you realize how ridiculous sheep act and the predicaments, they get themselves into, you'll realize it's not always a blessing to be referenced as a sheep. Like sheep sometimes we get our heads stuck where they don't belong, headbutt each other for no reason, and even run away from our Shepherd when he reaches out to pull us out of fences we have put ourselves into.

We must lean to the Good Shepherd!
