## **Prayer, A Constant Connection**

I'm sure you noticed, over the last year or so, crews putting in fiber optics all around town. First the little colored flags show up marking current utilities. Then holes are dug, and the optics are laid. Finally, everything is put back in place like nothing ever happened. Eventually, the whole system will be complete and newer, faster internet will be available. All of this to help us stay connected. Faster connections to the internet and information available there along with clearer connections to those we know. I for one, am looking forward to it and hoping that the cost will be less. Cross your fingers.

Of course, this is assuming you have paid for the service...and that you have the correct routers and modems...and that your devices are connected...and that the power doesn't go out. If any of that happens...no connection.

Now consider the connection available to God through prayer. It is always on...always. God is never asleep nor too busy. He hears the words coming out of your mouth and the words you speak in your mind. There is no special passcode to enter. There is no payment required. God is always available.

In the Gospel of Matthew, there is a section in 6:5-15 where Jesus teaches his disciples about prayer. It is simple and direct. Read through that section. Perhaps even memorize the prayer which is often called, "The Lord's Prayer." I encourage you, use the connection to God that is readily available. God wants to hear from you. For further consider, read these scriptures on prayer:

- 1 Thessalonians 5:17, "pray continually."
- James 5:13, "Is anyone among you in trouble? Let them pray."
- 1 John 5:14, "This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us."
- Ephesians 6:18. "And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people."
