**Sermon Thought:**

How do we determine God’s will for our lives? It is hard to know and maybe we don’t get it right every time. Don’t fret, Paul and Silas didn’t get it right all the time either.

## Heroes of Faith

### Nahum

As we reflect on the messages God gave our **heroes of faith** to deliver to his people, we need to take time to assess how we are doing in light of those messages. They give me great concern as I look at the things that are happening in America. In so many ways, we have taken God out of the picture and are following the passions of the flesh. The reality of God's wrath being poured out on us if we don't repent and turn from our evil ways looms ever before us. We see this played out in Nahum's prophecy against Nineveh.

It was encouraging to see how Nineveh repented when they heard Jonah's prophecy, and God's wrath was withdrawn from them. But it did not last and Nahum now has the task of pronouncing God's final judgment on them. Our **hero of faith** points to their ruthless military power and dishonest merchants who acquire wealth at the expense of morality and honesty. The Lord tells them, "*Behold, I am against you, says the Lord of hosts, and will lift up your skirts over your face; and I will let nations look on your nakedness and kingdoms on your shame*" (3:5). It grieves my heart to think that this same judgment will be poured out against America if we don't return to serving the Lord instead of our own pleasures and desires. As Nahum writes, "*Who can stand before his indignation? Who can endure the heat of his anger? His wrath is poured out like fire, and the rocks are broken asunder by him. The Lord is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble; he knows those who take refuge in him*" (1:6-7). The Lord has indeed been good to America, and we have been blessed by it. However, we must take seriously the reality that his wrath can and will be poured out against us if we do not honor and glorify him. As we turn to him, he will take care of our every need and secure our souls in his eternal presence.

We've all seen it happen too often - on the news or in everyday life. Life-threatening bleeding can happen in people injured in serious accidents or disasters. Instead of being a witness, you can become an immediate responder because you know how to Stop The Bleed.
