In 1934, Theodore Jones and Henry Grob made a discovery most children only dream about. Jones and Grob had started a secret club and were burying the box that would hold the club's treasure and secrets. Digging in the dirt floor of Jones's cellar, the teens discovered the Holy Grail of childhood fantasy-real buried treasure! They first came across a shiny \$20 gold coin. When Their excavation was complete, the boys had unearthed 3,558 century-old gold coins, a fortune that would be worth more than \$10 million today.
