Esther 7

Sermon Thought:

Haman's hatred and evil plotting turned against him when the king discovered his true intentions. He was impaled on the pole he had set up for someone else. Proverbs 26:27 teaches that if you set a trap for others, you shouldn't be surprised if you get caught in it yourself. What happened to Haman demonstrates this with violent clarity. When it comes to Jesus' teaching, "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you," rings true in this account.

- 1. What about Esther's speech stands out to you? When have you taken courage to speak up in the past?
- 2. How might Haman's life have gone differently if he had followed the "golden rule"?
- 3. How are "love your enemies" and "the golden rule" similar and different?
