## Waiting

I don't know how much of my life I have spent waiting. At Disney land, my family waited in lines with signs that post the wait time for rides...30 minutes, 45 minutes, 90 minutes sometimes. At the DMV I've waited up to 3 hours (I know, some of you have waited longer there). The airport allows lots of time to wait in multiple lines: Check-in, TSA security check, boarding line, waiting to take off, waiting to land, and finally waiting on luggage. Most of this waiting is done with nothing to do other than stand or sit while slowly moving forward one or two steps every few minutes.

Followers of God are also familiar with another form of waiting...waiting for the glorious return of Jesus Christ. John wrote Jesus' words in John 14:3, "if I go and prepare ap lace for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am." After Jesus ascended to heaven angels asked Jesus' disciples, "why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven," Acts 1:11. Finally, Jesus says in Revelation 22:12, "Look, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to each person according to what they have done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End." So here we are again...waiting.

Luckily for us, waiting for Jesus' return doesn't mean standing in line doing nothing. He has given his followers plenty to do while we wait. Jesus said, "(A lamp) gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven," Matthew 5:16. Shining your light means living life in a way that reflects God: giving generously, forgiving freely, working hard to make lives better and speaking truth with our words. So, waiting for Jesus means working and waiting, waiting, and working...simultaneously...go forth and work! (while you wait).
