Revealing God

Human Life

Human life is an amazing creation. It is so unfathomable how two microscopic cells can join together and become a living being. The miraculous process involves developing the bone structure, muscles, tendons, organs, skin, and a brain that controls so much who we are and become. Our hearts pump life sustaining blood through our newly formed bodies to give us **human life**. This is all followed by an amazing growth process where a tiny baby is slowly transformed into a human adult.

It all came about in the beginning of creation when "God said, 'Let us make man in our image, after out likeness... So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them... then the Lord God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being'" (Gen. 1:26, 27 & 2:7). At the center **of human life** is our eternal soul that God placed in our physical bodies to complete our being created "in our image, after our likeness." I love how the psalmist acknowledges God's involvement in our human development. "For thou didst form my inward parts, thou didst knit me together in my mother's womb" (Ps. 139:13). God took special care to create a human life that was capable of taking care of the things he created. He even placed with us, as male and female, the ability to bring forth new life, just like he created from the dust of the earth. Yes, we are indeed "fearfully and wonderfully made" as the psalmist declares (Ps. 139:14). Because of that, we have a responsibility to go forth and do the work the Lord gave us to do – to be his presence on earth so others can see him working through us. When this **human life** is finished, "the dust returns to the earth as it was, and the spirit returns to God who gave it" (Ecc. 12:7). We belong to God! **Gordon Jantz**
