## **A Spiritual Journey**

#### The Unseen

The journeys we take in life are laced with going to places we have never seen. This often causes us to have some anxieties, but the dominant factor remains the good feeling of excitement of what it will be like to enjoy our intended destination. Our spiritual journey is also dominated by the unseen reality of what lies ahead as we strive to do God's will. Paul tells us, "We look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen; for the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal" (2 Cor. 4:18).

The unseen is God's Spirit working in our hearts and minds, guiding us in our spiritual journey and our study of his holy and divine word. When we step out as Christians to share the gospel, the Holy Spirit guides us in what to say. Jesus teaches us "not to be anxious how you are to speak or what you are to say; for what you are to say will be given to you in that hour" (Matt. 10:19-20). As precious souls receive the word and obey it, we see the physical effects of what is unseen. As we behold the manifestation of God's work, we receive strength and courage as we mature in our faith on our spiritual journey. Because as Paul says "we walk by faith not by sight" (2 Cor. 5:7). It is through our eyes of faith that we see the unseen things we know are there! "Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen" (Heb. 11:1). Faith is what allows us to believe in God and that he sent his Son to earth to save us. Then, it is again through faith that we are obedient to God's every command; loving each other as Christ loved us and growing in the grace and knowledge of the Lord (2 Pet. 3:18). The unseen element of our spiritual journey allows us to live our lives for God and share our faith through our daily walk knowing God is with us in everything we do.
