**Sermon Scripture:**

Psalm 95

**Sermon Thought:**

True worship is both an action and an attitude, centered on God rather than ourselves or our circumstances. We worship not just because of what God has done for us, but because of who He is—worthy, holy, and sovereign. While worship can be joyful and fulfilling, it can also be hindered by worry, self-focus, or pain, which draw our attention away from God.

**Sermon Questions:**

1. In what ways have you found it challenging—or rewarding—to balance both the heart and the habit of worship in your daily life?
2. How can we shift our focus in worship from seeking what God can give us to simply honoring who God is?
3. Which of these hindrances has impacted your worship most recently, and how might you work through it to reconnect with God?

**Revealing God – A Superior Covenant  
Loving Discipline**

O how we love discipline! We simply can't wait for our parents, bosses, or anyone to see the things we are doing wrong and render appropriate discipline. Don't turn your back on me so quickly, because it is true that we are who we are today due to the discipline we have received throughout our lives. It is an essential part of life and testifies to the love and care that others have for us. Discipline molds us and shapes us into the human vessels we are so we can remain on the right path in life. Can you imagine what we would be today without the concept of discipline?

Throughout the history of God's people, they often wandered away from his holy and divine presence, and God had to discipline them so they would return to him. Because of God's discipline, his will for mankind has been completed through his Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord. The Hebrews writer addresses the necessity and result of discipline. *"My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, nor lose courage when you are punished by him. For the Lord disciplines him whom he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives... For they [our earthly fathers] disciplined us for a short time at their pleasure, but he [God] disciplines us for our good, that we may share his holiness... For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant; later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it"* (Heb. 12:5-11). Yes indeed, **loving discipline** is the key to our eternal life with the Father. Now we can all say together, O how we love discipline! God loves us and wants us to be with him in the glory of heaven. Our lives are made whole and complete through his discipline. We can feel his presence as we walk together on our spiritual journey. Thank you, God, for your **loving discipline!**
