Sermon Scripture:

Proverbs 3:9-10 – *“Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the first fruits of all your produce; then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine.”*

Sermon Thought:

Money is one of the most personal and stressful parts of life—yet the Bible addresses it more than 2,000 times. Our culture teaches principles like saving, budgeting, and staying out of debt, but Scripture goes even deeper by reminding us that everything belongs to God. We are stewards, not owners. God doesn't want money to control us—He wants us to use it to honor Him and bless others.

Sermon Questions:

1. Why do you think money is such a personal and difficult topic to discuss—even among Christians?
2. Which of the biblical principles about money (give, save, spend, work, plan) is easiest for you to practice, and which is most challenging? Why?
3. In what ways can our approach to money reveal the condition of our hearts and our trust in God?
