**Sowing and Sharing**

Sowing seed is every Christian's job. Each of us is called to share the good news; no one can fulfill this task on behalf of someone else. It is your job to sow your seed, just as it is my job to sow mine. Together, we are entrusted with the privilege of spreading the word of God. Importantly, this is more than just a duty or a task; it should be a genuine delight. If Jesus is truly Lord, if He is worth knowing and loving, then He is certainly a Savior worth sharing with others.

Just as there are unbreakable laws in the physical world, such as gravity—what goes up must come down—there are also spiritual laws that never fail. One such law is the principle of sowing and reaping. If you sow, you will reap. You reap what you sow, and you only reap if you sow. This is a truth that farmers inherently understand; without faith in this principle, no one would plant their crops. Every farmer sows with the expectation of a harvest.

In the same way, God has established this law in the spiritual realm. When we sow the seeds of the Gospel—the Good News—into the lives of people who do not know Jesus, we participate in an eternal harvest. While we can plant the seed, it is God alone who gives growth. We do not possess the power to make the seed flourish; our role is simply to sow the Gospel. There is joy in this process: we get to do the planting and then watch as God brings about growth. Wow! What an amazing opportunity!

Sow the seed! Sow the seed! Sow the seed!

Let us be faithful and enthusiastic in sowing the seed. Continue to sow, trusting that God will bring forth the harvest in His time.
