**Sermon Scripture:** Hebrews 10

**Sermon Thought:**

Jesus told his followers he would return. Until then, we are to look forward with anticipation of his coming. Hebrews 10 gives us five "Let Us" phrases to consider while we wait: draw near to God, hold unswervingly, consider how we may spur one another on, continue meeting together, and encourage one another.

**Sermon Questions:**

1. Which habits or rhythms help you stay spiritually close to God in seasons when life feels routine or heavy, and which habits tend to pull you away?
2. What makes it difficult to hold firmly to hope in Christ today, and what does "unswerving" faith look like in real, everyday decisions?
3. Hebrews 10 ties Christ's return to how we treat each other. What are practical ways our group can encourage, challenge, and strengthen one another as we wait for Jesus' coming?
