**Sermon Scripture:** Matthew 20:1-16

**Sermon Thought:** Every follower of God should have his or her eyes set on one destination: to walk the streets of the eternal promised land after hearing, "Well done, good and faithful servant." There is a lot that can happen on the road between here and there. This journey is full of ups and downs, rough patches, and smooth parts. The apostle Paul compares it to running a race with runners pressing in, jostling, and cutting each other off; all the while keeping eyes on the goal, the destination, the finish line. In the parable of the workers, the workers each had a different number of difficulties, but each received the prize.

**Sermon Questions:**

1. In the parable, every worker—no matter when they started—received the same reward. How does this challenge the way you think about your own journey toward hearing "well done, good and faithful servant"?
2. Paul describes the Christian life as a race full of jostling, obstacles, and setbacks. What "race conditions" have made your spiritual journey difficult lately, and how have they shaped your focus on the finish line?
3. The early workers struggled because they compared their path to someone else's. Where do you find yourself tempted to compare your spiritual progress with others, and how might keeping your eyes on the destination change that?
